It contributes to the writing of a new historiography of cinema by shedding light on the works of women in the media industry and aims to renew theoretical approaches to cinema and feminism by studying women's films. The project includes screenings and filmmaking as experiences to be shared with students and pupils to foster a critical eye towards gender prejudice and inequalities.
